### CROSS OF NAILS

On the night of 14th November, 1940, Coventry and its cathedral endured a relentless bombing campaign. Much of Coventry and its cathedral were left in ruins and only the outer shell of the walls and tower remained standing. In the days that followed two symbols merged from the rubble; two charred roof beams had fallen in the shape of a cross and three medieval roof nails had also melted into a cross, which became the Anglican Cross of Nails - a symbol now of peace, friendship and reconciliation.

# The Cross of Nails 2018

The Diocesan Centenary 2018 cross of nails pilgrimage arrived at Wellesbourne CE Primary School on Tuesday 12th June 2018, from Moreton Morrell CE Primary. The School Council received the cross and a special assembly was held for all staff and pupils.



The cross will then journey from Wellesbourne CE Primary to Kineton CE Primary later in the week. A total of 76 schools across the diocese have been involved in the centenary celebrations.
