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Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to a brand new academic year at Wellesbourne. A warm welcome to all our new children and to Miss Scott our new Year 1 teacher and KS1 leader.

Please will you pass on to friends and family that we are looking for Midday Supervisors at the moment as we have had a few members of staff move on or take on different roles.

PARENTPAY/SCHOOL DINNERS

As you know, all children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 receive a free school lunch. Children in Years 3, 4, 5, and 6 will need to pay the new price of **£2.30** per day in advance. The prices for this term are:
£2.30 per day
£11.50- week,
£170.20 - Whole Term

Just a reminder that we will not take payments in cash (apart from water bottles and book bags available at the school office) unless there are exceptional circumstances agreed in advance with Mr Hewitt or Mrs Oscrift. Outstanding dinner money will result in your child **not receiving a meal** if a prior reminder has been ignored by parents. A lunch costs £2.30 each day.

BANK CLOSURE

Please can I remind parents that due to the bank closing we can no longer accept cash or cheques in school. Please make all payments using ParentPay, unless it is a fundraising or charity event.

ACCELERATED READER CURRICULUM EVENING

Reminder: PARKING

DROPPING OFF/PICKING UP

- 4) Please do not park along or use the slip road leading to the Annexe site.
