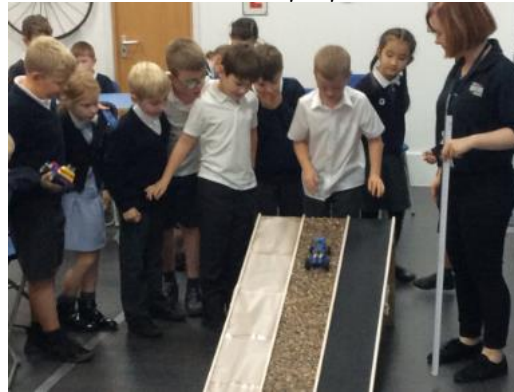

PARKING SIGNS

Our little signs have been doing their important jobs as often as they can - as long as it isn't windy - and have had a really good impact on parking which has improved overall but there is still work to be done.



Therefore, at pick up and drop off times, the PSCOs and the council will be out and about when they can encouraging good parking. In the meantime, can we all ensure that we are

following these simple rules:

- 1) Never park or stop (even for a second) on the zig-zag lines during school hours.
- 2) Avoid parking near corners on Mountford Close as these are 'blind spots'.
- 3) Avoid parking over residents' driveways.
- 4) Parking close to the junction of Newbold Road creates problems for the main road - if possible, please avoid parking there.
