SRE MEETING WITH JONNY HUNT



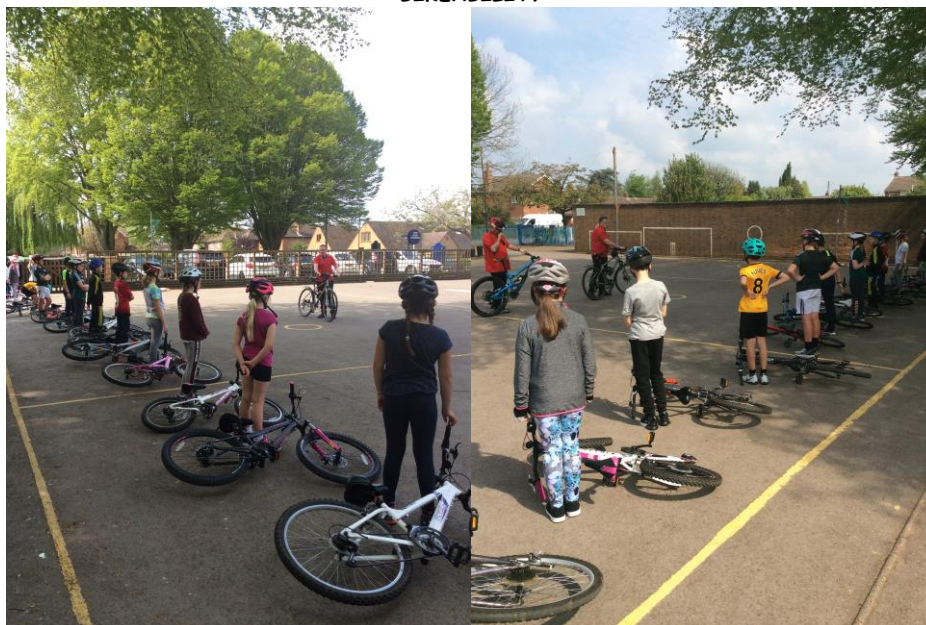
