### PARKING



PLEASE may we remind all parents that parking at the school is still a matter that needs consideration at all times.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON THE ANNEXE BUILDING!!

As you may be aware, the building was due to be completed this summer term but due to planning objections, there have had to be changes and resubmissions which have caused a delay. However, following a successful planning meeting, the building will now go ahead with the reconfiguration of rooms in the current KS1 building starting on July 22<sup>nd</sup>. The main hall itself will be started in October and we hope to have occupation by half term in February at the very latest.

**Therefore, as a result of this, the school will close at 1:30pm on 19<sup>th</sup> July to allow the removal firm time to pack and store the furniture and resources from the building.**

Please collect your children from the usual place at 1:30pm. WOOSH will be available for **current** WOOSH children until 5:00pm. Any other parents who wish their child to attend WOOSH that afternoon will need to contact WOOSH on, 07790 596992 where some places may be available at a small cost until 3.15pm

Again as a consequence of the delays, we have had to put an additional INSET day at the start of next term to ensure that the classrooms are ready for the children. Therefore, Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September will be INSET days (including Nursery) and all the children will start back on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September.

We apologise for the disruption and we thank you for your cooperation.

## WOOSH

We are currently accepting registration forms for WOOSH places for Sept 2019. If your child is not currently registered with WOOSH and you would like a place for September, please ask for a WOOSH booklet with registration form at the school office. If your child is currently on a plan, or attends on an ad-hoc basis, the new registration form **MUST** be completed. If your form is not returned by the deadline, you may lose your child's place and neither will we be able to accept your child, even if a place is available for any requested one-off sessions.
