Thank you for the very generous donations of tins and dried food you gave towards Harvest Festival this year.

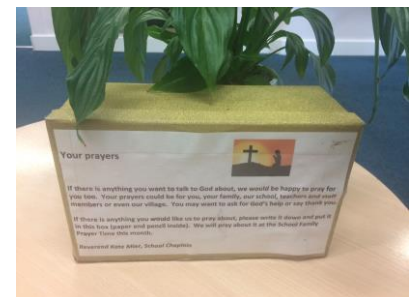
WATER BOTTLES
