APPEAL TO PARENTS OVER PARKING

Parking is, and always will be, an issue at our village school as it was not designed for the number of children that we currently have. I was visited by a police officer this week who asked me to mention in our Newsletter that a few parents/carers are parking dangerously again on Newbold Road. The police have said that people parking without due care and attention, those who park opposite a junction or within 10m of a junction are likely to get a fine. You have been warned! I appreciate that it is difficult but the simplest solution is if you can walk, then please do so. Another option would be to park further away from school as Newbold Road is far too crowded and walk from there.

Also, please remember that there is **no** access through the school gates for cars between 8.30am and 4.30pm. Please do not drive into the car park during these hours. **This includes parents who are dropping off or collecting their children from WOOSH.** This is for the safety of all our children.
