As the weather indicates that it will turn very cold again, it is timely for us to remind you of the procedure if for any reason the School and Nursery need to be closed, although this is very rare.

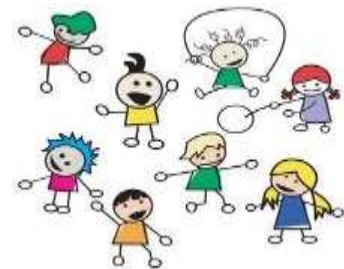
