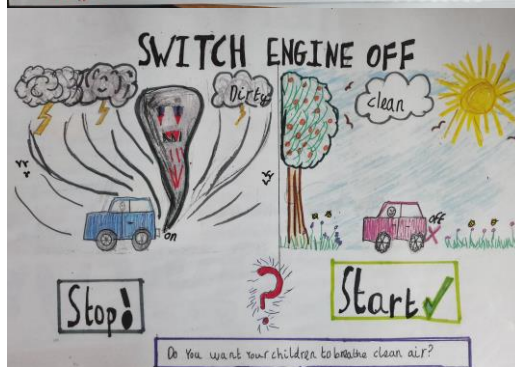
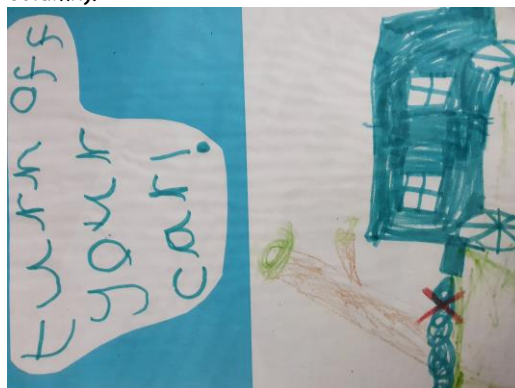
YOUNG VOICES
