- Family Liaison Officer available to all schools
- Support with attendance, finances, SEMH, housing
- Access and signposting to opportunities and community support
- Parenting classes and network

Good Mental and Physical Health

- Counselling services for pupils
- Emotion coaching for all community
- Supervision for staff including 'Listening ear'
- Coaching for staff
- Pupil mentoring
- Surplus food donations

Church and Clergy

- Network of local clergy and foundation governors
- Strategic local support with liaison to offer complimentary services
- Use of facilities for parenting programmes
- Chaplaincy enhanced for all members of the community
- Links to Children and Family Leader
- Youth provision

Early access to Specialist Services

- Inclusion and Pastoral Leadership across all schools coordinating support and services
- Link with SEND Supported, Educational Psychologists and other services
- Links to health team, local medical centres
- Coordination of local Significant Adult Person (SAP) to support pupils at risk of being out of school
