Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to share with you the report from our recent Ofsted inspection in February. It will be published on both the school website and the Ofsted Website shortly.

We had a two day *ungraded visit* as part of the usual Ofsted cycle to make sure the school remained 'Good'. The inspector scrutinised all aspects of the school in the five categories of the Inspection Framework: Quality of Education, Behaviour and Attitudes, Personal Development, Leadership and Management and Early Years. The inspector visited 12 lessons, read with children in Years 1, 2 and 3, spoke with various groups of children from across the school, looked at books, met with staff and governors, analysed documents and spoke to parents and carers.

The Inspector praised the school and the feedback we received was positive. There was one main area to work on – and this is outlined at the end of the report - but the inspector agreed with leaders' assessment of the school and commented on the strength of the leadership team. The inspector was impressed by our ambitious curriculum and how children with SEND are supported as well as the pastoral support in our school offered by the team in school.

The Ofsted Inspector in particular praised the behaviour of children both in lessons and around school as well as mentioning their 'love of learning'. She was impressed with the way children show kindness to each other as well as developing the other key values of the school (resilience and service) and how they move around the school, show respect and engage with others at playtimes with OPAL. We are so incredibly proud of the children in our school and how they strive to 'be the best that they can be'.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our staff and governors at Wellesbourne. They are a dedicated and professional team and we are grateful for how they 'go above and beyond' for the families of our school and the whole school community.

Thank you to the many parents and carers who responded to the Parent View survey or spoke to the inspector during the inspection. Please take time to read the report. We are pleased with the outcome and, as always, are determined to maintain our effectiveness over the next few years in partnership with you and all our major stakeholders.
